

Q Can I ever see my child again?

Q Do I have to take my baby home?

A Adoptive families are prepared to be at the hospital. The baby can be discharged directly to them or to one of our staff members.

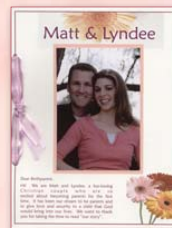
