

Happy January!

No rest for the wicked, they say! We are getting geared up for our March for Life trip to Washington DC!

Four buses full of lively 8th graders will be heading out in a few weeks to let America know that Dubuque County is Pro-Life! We will pass through mountains and snow, through Steeler territory (which is a dangerous place for a Packers fan), through sleepless nights. We will remain joyful and unmoved in our belief that all life is precious. Our rally cry will echo around us- love saves lives, love saves lives, love saves lives! Join us in praying for an end to abortion and all things that disregard the human person.

January is National Slavery and Human Trafficking Prevention Month. The fact that women and children are being used and sold is an abomination. The fact that several Planned Parenthood workers have been recorded giving advice to pimps on how to get abortions and other services for their underage “workers” is even worse. The average age of entry into child

prostitution is 13. Often the girls are forced to have multiple abortions in order for them to continue their “work”. The Truth About Abortion

What are human rights? According to the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR), they are defined as inherited traits that every human has regardless of sex or race. Among these basic rights, are right to Liberty, the right to a fair and speedy trial, but most importantly, the right to Life. The right to life is one of the most basic human rights that everyone inherits; it says so in our constitution. If our rights come from God, and God is all moral, then wouldn't it be immoral to deny someone life? Well, this is the reality for millions of unborn human babies around the world. Many of them are denied this basic human right of life. They are denied their human rights by the very sinful operation called abortion. Abortion is immoral because it puts political expediency above God-given human rights causing the murder of millions of unborn babies whose life began at conception.

As Catholics, we understand that human life, and therefore human rights, begin at conception. This is controversial given that the entity inside of the womb is sometimes referred to as a "fetus", or not a person. This is misleading because science has proven that life begins at conception. "The American College of Pediatricians concurs with the body of scientific evidence that corroborates that a unique human life starts when the sperm and egg bind to each other in a process of fusion of their respective membranes and a single hybrid cell called a zygote, or one-cell embryo, is

created." (June, Para. 14). What is even more amazing is that just six weeks after conception, the baby's heart begins to beat, and the life becomes more recognizable as a human being. This unique person will never be created again as it has special gene patterns that will never be duplicated again by God. "For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb." (Book of Psalms 139:13). The Bible says that every baby is unique and God's creation. Every time a baby is aborted, it is an abomination to God because He created this life in His image, and it is destroyed by the hand of man, who has no authority to do so.

According to dictionary.com, murder is defined as the unlawful premeditated killing of one human being by another. We already know that life begins at conception; science and God Himself proved that, so therefore, an unborn baby is a human. This clearly means that abortion is murder. "So, is abortion murder? The answer is certainly yes. Abortion is the willful and unjustified killing of an unborn child. Regardless if abortion is legal by human government." (Beckwith, Pa. 12). According to Trulife.org, just because abortion is legal by a government, doesn't mean it is a moral thing to do. This was a revelation to Norma McCorvey or "Jane Roe", as she was known as to the media. In 1973, she pursued a lawsuit that went to the Supreme Court to make abortion legal in the U.S. She won a 7-2 decision and abortion became legal all across the country. Years later, McCorvey saw what abortion was doing to innocent babies. In a 2008 ad for Catholic News Agency, McCorvey detailed her change of view on abortion after she became a Christian in the mid-1990's. "Upon knowing God, I realized that my case, which legalized abortion on demand, was the biggest mistake of my life," she said (Trinko, Pa. 5).

According to the Daily Signal, Jane Roe released an ad about how much she regretted that lawsuit she filed in 1973 and would continue to regret until her death. Jane Roe was a pro-life advocate for the rest of her life because she knew that these babies had done nothing wrong, but they were being eliminated.

Do you know what is weird? When a pregnant woman dies because of another human, that person is charged with *two* counts of murder. One for the mother and one for her baby. If that is considered an immoral murder of a baby in that situation, then why isn't it for abortion? Abortion should be considered immoral because murder is already immoral. "The only thing preventing abortion from being included in the definition of murder is that it's currently not 'unlawful' (Brown, Pa 2). Lifenews.com says that the only thing that makes abortion okay is that the government says so. This is not true, as we mentioned in the last paragraph, just because it is okayed by a human government, doesn't mean that it is the right thing to do. I hate to break it to you, but human rights do not end where the government begins. Our rights come from God, and abortion is not one of them. Murder is bad and abortion should be considered bad as well because, at its core, abortion is murder!

On the brighter side of things, the Pro-Life

movement is having an effect! Abortion rates have been going down in the U.S. Even the smallest drop is a huge victory for life! Abortion clinics have been closing, and all but six states and the District of Columbia, have all seen drops in the operation. The sharpest declines occurred in the West and the South (16% in each region), while smaller declines were seen in the Northeast (11%) and the Midwest (9%)" (Guttmacher Pa. 4). According to Guttmacher.com, the biggest decline happened in the west and south. These numbers are at historical lows, but this number is still way too high. The pro-life movement should never stop fighting abortion until the number of abortions performed hits zero.

Abortion is simply and plainly the murder of someone who did not do anything wrong. It robs mankind of the infinite potential these lives hold. These lives are terminated when an abortion is performed. On the moral scale, everyone should know that abortion is the murder of a child of God. Life is a journey, do not cancel a road trip!

PLANNED PARENTHOOD *FINALLY* UNDER INVESTIGATION



In 2015, the Center for Medical Progress released shocking videos showing Planned Parenthood officials discussing the sale of tissue from aborted babies. These videos showed horrific conversations. One video depicted a Planned Parenthood worker making a joke about eyeballs falling onto her lap. After two years of waiting, the Department of Justice has initiated an investigation into Planned Parenthood. A Senate Judiciary Committee published its findings last year and Committee Chairman Chuck Grassley had pressed for an investigation into the following companies: Planned

Parenthood Federation of America; All Planned Parenthood affiliates that have engaged in paid fetal tissue transfers within the statute of limitations; Advanced Bioscience Resources, Inc; Novogenix Laboratories, LLC; and StemExpress, LLC.

We hope that the Department of Justice will be able to help expose Planned Parenthood for what it truly is: an abortion company set on making profits. Fortunately for us, Planned Parenthood closed 32 clinics in 2017 alone while opening a mere 5 clinics! This is good news and a lot of credit can go towards David Daleiden and his coworkers at the Center for Medical Progress who released the videos. Attorney General Xavier Becerra's office charged David with 14 counts of violating a California law against recording conversations without consent. U.S. District Judge William Orrick ordered the two lawyers representing Daleiden to pay nearly \$200,000 in contempt-of-court fines for releasing the recordings that Daleiden had taken. The Center for Medical Progress has filed a petition seeking to exclude Judge Orrick from the lawsuits because he has close ties with Planned Parenthood. Judge Orrick helped open, run and fund a Planned Parenthood clinic while in a leadership role at a San Francisco family resource center. This should disqualify Judge Orrick from this lawsuit. Hopefully the court will agree.

FERTILITY AWARENESS BASED METHODS



With all the news in the papers about birth control being linked to depression and breast cancer, many women are looking for a better option. Fertility Awareness Based Methods of family planning has thus seen an increase in interest. This is based

on observations and helping women to understand their bodies. There are many resources and apps that are becoming more popular and helpful. These apps are being used by women in all stages of life to help in monitoring their health and planning their family.

FACTS (Fertility Appreciation Collaborative to Teach the Science) is a group of physicians, healthcare professionals and educators working together to provide information about natural or fertility awareness based methods of family planning with the medical community. Their goal is “to share the best evidence available with our healthcare colleagues and students so they can: educate women and men about their fertility, empower them to make more informed choices about family planning and enable women to collaborate with medical professionals to better monitor and manage their reproductive health”. 



Subverted: How I Helped the Sexual Revolution Hijack the Women's Movement by Sue Ellen Browder
