A Note From Augustine Payne, Executive Director



Happy New Year!!! 2021 has been an eventful year. Thank you for your support of Dubuque County Right To Life this past year - whether in time, talent or treasure - your support is greatly appreciated!! In 2022, may we start to see the visible fruits of our efforts to build a culture of life.

January is the month we traditionally recall the sad day abortion was made legal. Since 1973, an estimated 63,000,000 children's lives have been lost to abortion. That is aside from the millions of mothers, fathers, and friends, whose lives have been scarred from losing a child to abortion.

On December 1st, Dobbs v. Jackson was heard by the Supreme Court. As most of you might be aware, Dobbs v. Jackson is Mississippi's attempt to overturn Roe v. 
5th Grade Poster Contest winners



Pro-Life Court and Legislation Update

As you know from our update in December's newsletter, the U.S. Supreme Court heard oral arguments in the case of *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*. A decision on that case is not expected until 2022.

In the meantime, the Supreme Court continues to wrestle with S.B.8, the Texas heartbeat law that protects babies with heartbeats and their moms from abortion. On December 10, 2021 the Court issued a ruling that limited, but did not fully eliminate, the ability of abortion clinics to continue their challenge to the Heartbeat Law in the lower Texas courts. The Supreme Court ruled that the abortionists' lawsuit can continue against a group of State medical licensing officials in Texas, but not against the judges and clerks in the courthouse who the abortionists had also tried to sue. Importantly, the Supreme Court denied the Biden Administration's request to put the Texas law on hold while these cases work their way through the courts. A five justice majority of Clarence Thomas, Samuel Alito, Neil Gorsuch, Brett Kavanaugh, and Amy Coney Barrett voted to prevent the abortionists from proceeding with their lawsuit against the judges and clerks. Most importantly, the Supreme Court let the Texas law continue in effect while cases worked their way through the lower courts! This is important because babies are being saved and mothers are being helped. Remember, the State of Texas has designated \$100 million to helping women in crisis pregnancies and their babies both before and after birth so that they do not have to choose abortion.

In other news, the Ohio House of Representatives passed a Bill requiring life-saving treatment for any baby who survives an abortion. S.B.157, the Born-Live Infant Protection Act, now heads to the Ohio Governor's office for signature. Of significance, the Bill passed overwhelmingly in both the Ohio House and Senate. It is clear that the Bill is supported by overwhelming majority of Ohio citizens' in view of how their Representatives voted...pro-life!

Iowa does not have a specific Born Alive Infant Protection Act like Ohio's, but we do have a feticide law, Iowa Code 707.7 It was passed years ago by the Iowa legislature and was meant to protect unborn babies from abortion in the 3rd trimester. However, it is meaningless due to *Roe v. Wade*. Like every other similar law in every state, *Roe v. Wade* allows abortion up to the moment of birth as long as "in the best clinical judgment of the physician" the abortion is performed to "preserve the life or health" of the mother. Because the Supreme Court's definition of "health" is so broad, feticide in Iowa is a protection in name only. Abortion is legal in Iowa and every state up to the moment of birth and don't let anyone tell you otherwise. Hopefully the Supreme Court will reverse *Roe v. Wade* by means of the *Dobbs* case and Iowa can move on to passage of the Protect Life Amendment.

DCRTL, Inc. will continue its educational efforts on these and other important life issues.

A “Brave” New World??

Australian doctor, Philip Nitschke, recently announced his creation of a 3-D printed “suicide pod” called a “Sarco” machine that will be available for use in Switzerland in 2022. Assisted suicide is currently legal in Switzerland for anyone over the age of 12 years, but children under 16 years of age must have a parent’s permission.

In his communication to Swiss media, Nitschke simply and callously describes the dying process in his contraption: *“Death takes place through hypoxia and hypocapnia, oxygen and carbon dioxide deprivation, respectively...”*¹ while at the same time admitting that he is seeking to have all psychiatric requirements removed in order for a person to commit suicide whenever, wherever, and for whatever reason, without the presence of a doctor.

Every life is a gift, and if you or someone you know is contemplating suicide, help is available.

Illinois

On Friday, December 17th, Governor J.B. Pritzker signed into law HB 370, the “Youth Health and Safety Act” which repealed the Parental Notice law in Illinois. Previously, parents, guardians, or a trusted adult, were only required to be notified when a minor was presented for an abortion, not to give consent. Now in Illinois, no notification is required in order for a minor to have an abortion. Illinois legislators approved the law, despite major appeals by pro-lifers, victims of sex-trafficking, and the organizations that help these victims.

California

In an article published by Breitbart on December 8th, Governor Gavin Newsome promised that if Roe v. Wade is overturned California will become an abortion sanctuary. Women from out of state seeking an abortion will potentially receive free accommodations and child-care at taxpayer expense.

The California Future of Abortion (CA FAB) Council, composed of 40 abortion industry and advocacy groups, has compiled a list of 45 recommendations for the state legislature to consider in the event that Roe is overturned.

FDA Changes Abortion Pill By Mail Guidelines

In April 2021, citing Covid-19 concerns, the FDA approved the sale of the abortifacient RU-486 (also known as Mifeprex or another generic form of mifepristone) by mail over the internet. On Thursday, December 16th, The FDA made what was supposed to be temporary, a permanent change.

In a letter to the FDA signed by 23 medical professionals and pro-life activists it is noted that “Since it was approved in 2000 to be sold as Mifeprex, there have been over 4000 reported adverse events, including 24 maternal deaths. Since 2016, the FDA only requires abortion pill manufacturers to report maternal deaths... Manufacturers gather this information from the prescribers, such as Planned Parenthood facilities. According to the Association of Pro-Life Obstetricians and Gynecologists, the abortion pill poses a four-times higher risk of complication than surgical abortion in the first trimester. Yet, abortion industry advocates recklessly insist on the abortion pill’s later-term use; its availability without a prescription, blood work, or ultrasound.”
