SUPREME COURT OVERTURNS ROE V. WADE!

In a well-reasoned and all-encompassing ruling, a five-Justice majority of the United States Supreme Court overruled *Roe v. Wade* in the case of *Dobbs v. Jackson's Women's Health Organization*. Pro-life activists, educators, and citizens around the country and around the world hailed the decision as a long overdue repudiation of the flawed legal reasoning of *Roe*.

The Court upheld Mississippi's fifteen week limit on abortion, and sent the case back down to the District Court for further proceedings. Justice Samuel Alito, writing for the five-Justice majority stated: "It is time to heed the Constitution and return the issue of abortion to the people's elected representatives."

Justice Alito continues, "The permissibility of abortion, and the limitations, upon it, are to be resolved like most important questions in our democracy: by citizens trying to persuade one another and then voting. That is what the Constitution and the rule of law demand."

The majority opinion also slammed *Roe's* "viability" framework, noting that: "The most obvious problem with any such argument is that viability is heavily dependent on factors that have nothing to do with the characteristics of a fetus. One is the state of neonatal care at a particular point in time. Due to the development of new equipment and improved practices, the viability line has changed over the years . . . the (*Roe*) Court thus asserted raw judicial power to impose, as a matter of constitutional law, a uniform viability rule that allowed the States less freedom to regulate abortion than the majority of western democracies enjoy."

The Court noted that in returning the issue to the States, it allows "both sides of the abortion issue to seek to affect the legislative process by influencing public opinion, lobbying legislators, voting, and running for office."

The Court concluded with this message for the American people: "We end this opinion where we began. Abortion presents a profound moral question. The Constitution does not prohibit the citizens of each State from regulating or prohibiting abortion. *Roe* and *Casey* arrogated that authority. We now overrule those decisions and return that authority to the people and their elected representatives."

MAJOR PRO-LIFE VICTORY in Iowa Supreme Court

In a momentous ruling issued Friday, June 17, 2022, the Iowa Supreme Court overruled and reversed a 2018 Supreme Court Decision that found the Iowa Constitution contained a fundamental right to abortion. The case, *Planned Parenthood of the Heartland v. Reynolds*, reversed a District Court ruling from Polk County that held a law providing a 24-hour waiting period for an abortion violated the State Constitution. By a vote of 5 to 2, the Iowa Supreme Court reversed the 2018 pro-abortion ruling and remanded the case to the lower Court. Summarizing why the 2018 case was wrong, Iowa Supreme Court Justice Edward Mansfield wrote that the 2018 case “lacks textural and historical support. It is doctrinally inconsistent with prior Iowa Jurisprudence concerning family rights that followed a balancing approach. Its rhetoric is one-sided. Its constitutional footing is unsound.” The Mansfield opinion also criticized the 2018 case for finding that having an abortion without even a 72-hour delay was more important than preserving unborn life. Finally, Justice Mansfield and the other four Justices who joined him stated, “Constitutions—and courts—should not be picking sides in divisive social and political debates unless some universal principle of justice stands on only one side of that debate. Abortion isn’t one of those issues.”

This Decision by the Iowa Supreme Court still leaves the future of abortion law in Iowa unclear (even with the U.S. Supreme Court’s reversal of *Roe v. Wade*). The Protect Life Amendment to amend Iowa’s Constitution is still needed to make Iowa’s Constitution abortion-neutral. The Amendment would prohibit future courts in Iowa from finding a right to abortion in the Iowa Constitution. The Protect Life Amendment will be up for another vote in the Iowa Legislature in the Spring of 2023, making the November 2022 elections of our state representatives and senators of the utmost importance in Iowa.

In the meantime, this Decision by the Iowa Supreme Court is a swift and welcome reversal of the 2018 Iowa Supreme Court’s egregious constitutional error, and it will save the lives of many unborn children and protect their mothers from the harms of abortion.

Local pro-life organizations Clarity Clinic and Mary’s Inn joined representatives of Dubuque County Right to Life, Inc., in a press conference held the same day, hailing the *Dobbs* decision opening a new road to offering protection for unborn children and real solutions for women in crisis pregnancies to help them choose life rather than abortion.

Cassie Schetgen, President of Dubuque County Right to Life, Inc. stated: “Just as the Emancipation Proclamation signaled the beginning of the end of legal slavery in the United States, so the beginning of the end of legalized abortion in the U.S. began today when the Supreme Court reversed *Roe v. Wade*, returning the abortion issue to the states.”

DCRTL Executive Director Augustine Payne added: “The educational efforts of Dubuque County Right to Life, Inc., will continue unabated but will be bolstered by the freedom to offer life-changing alternatives to abortion-minded women in crisis who need our help.”

Dubuque County Right to Life will redouble its educational efforts so the people of Iowa work together to pass the Protect Life Amendment, stop abortion, and assist women in crisis to choose life.

PRO-LIFE COURT & LEGISLATION UPDATE

Dear Friends,

Of course, the big news is the Iowa Supreme Court's Decision of Friday, June 17, 2022 in Planned Parenthood of the Heartland v. Reynolds, and the U.S. Supreme Court's decision a week later on June 24th.. See the front page of this newsletter for details on the U.S. Supreme Court Case of Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization.

It is remarkable that the Iowa Supreme Court reversed itself in only 4 years (2018-2022), and corrected a terrible Constitutional error that occurred in 2018 when the Court found a so-called right to abortion in the Iowa Constitution. The current Supreme Court of Iowa, led by Associate Justice Edward Mansfield, Thomas Waterman, and Dana Oxley, recognized that there are women who will change their minds during a waiting period when they are informed through ultrasound of the humanity of their child, and also informed about the positive pro-life alternatives to abortions: adoption, parenting, and all of the help available from crisis pregnancy centers up to birth and beyond.

There is more good news.

The MOMS Bill (More Options for Maternal Support) was signed into law as part of the Health & Human Services budget on June 14, 2022. As referenced in earlier columns, the MOMS Bill will fund pregnancy support programs already in place in Dubuque County in meaningful ways that offer practical and profound assistance: medical, housing, education, baby needs, counseling, employment help, and everything from cribs to car seats.

In other good news, the Legislature passed and the Governor signed a bill amending the Safe Haven Law in Iowa. The Amendment allows an unwanted infant to be dropped off at a police station, fire station, or hospital within 90 days of birth, no questions asked. Most states have this law, but the amendment allowing a child to be delivered to a Safe Haven within 90 days of birth extends the time whereby a young mother could consider her options if she believes she cannot raise her child on her own. As we all know, there are millions of people in the nation willing to adopt an infant.

Finally, many of you have followed the recent legislative primary elections. Pro-life candidate Steve Bradley of Cascade prevailed over Lee Hein, and across the state other pro-life Republicans were undefeated in their primary contests. Please stay informed on the positions of all of the candidates on abortion in the local, state and federal elections set for Tuesday, November 8th.

The “Value them Both” Amendment

On August 2nd, Kansas voters will have the opportunity to voice their opinion on whether their State Constitution encompasses a fundamental right to abortion with the “Value them Both” Amendment. This would reverse the Kansas State Supreme Court 2019 ruling which found in their State Constitution a fundamental right to abortion.

This is similar to what Iowa is trying to do with the Protect Life Amendment, and that is to reverse a state supreme court ruling and make it so no future court can do so again.

Iowa Supreme Court Justice to retire

Iowa State Supreme Court Justice, Brent Appel, will retire on July 13th as he has reached the mandatory retirement age of 72. Justice Appel has been on the Court since 2006 when appointed by Gov. Vilsack. Justice Appel was one of the Justices who concurred with the majority opinion in saying that the Iowa Constitution held a “fundamental right to abortion”.

Five candidates have applied to fill the vacant seat. A 17-member nominating commission contains 8 members elected by Iowa attorneys and 9 appointed by the Governor. The Commission selects 3 candidates from which the Governor will choose the one to fill the vacancy.

Attorney General will not represent Iowa in court when it comes to abortion

Just prior to this newsletter going to press, on June 28th, Attorney General Tom Miller stated in a press release that he will be withdrawing from being involved in the case regarding the 24 hour waiting period (Planned Parenthood v. Kim Reynolds, et al) stating “I support the undue burden standard that the U.S. Supreme Court set forth in Planned Parenthood v. Casey. The 24-hour case has now moved to a point in which I doubt that I can zealously assert the state's position. The question now before the Iowa Supreme Court is whether the rational basis test should apply to abortion regulations.” Miller stated he could not support or advocate for such a change.

Governor Reynolds Response

Also on June 28th, Governor Kim Reynolds announced via press release, two future legal actions following the Dobbs v. Jackson Supreme Court decision. She stated “1. Gov. Reynolds will urge the Iowa Supreme Court to rehear Planned Parenthood v. Reynolds (known as PPH IV), in light of the U.S. Supreme Court’s decision in Dobbs. 2. Gov. Reynolds will request that the Iowa courts lift the injunction against enforcement of Iowa’s fetal heartbeat law.”

She went on to say “The Supreme Court’s historic decision reaffirms that states have the right to protect the innocent and defenseless unborn—and now it’s time for our state to do just that. As governor, I will do whatever it takes to defend the most important freedom there is: the right to life.” Due to the Attorney General Tom Miller withdrawing himself from representing Iowa in such cases, Gov. Reynolds said that Iowa will be represented by Alliance Defending Freedom and Iowa attorney, Alan Ostergren, President and Chief Counsel of Kirkwood Institute. Both will represent Iowa without costing the taxpayers a dime.

Pregnancy Center in Des Moines Vandalized

As noted in our past newsletter, there is no doubt that the leaking of the Dobbs draft opinion sparked violence throughout the country. A number of attacks have occurred since the leak in early May. Many have been directed towards Pregnancy Centers and Pro-Life organizations. A group that goes by the name of Jane's Revenge admitted to vandalizing Agape pregnancy counseling center in Des Moines, Iowa. They broke windows and graffitied the walls with lines such as "god loves abortion", "fake clinic", and "this place is not safe." Jane's Revenge alongside another group that goes by the name of Ruth Sent Us are two known groups heading the attacks and protests against the Pro-Life movement. Ruth Sent Us specifically comes up in the protests directed towards the Justices homes who were seen as leaning in favor of the overturn of Roe v. Wade.

Answered Prayers

In the days leading up to the Supreme Court decision on Dobbs, Nicholas Roske, 26, flew from California to Maryland with the intention to shoot Justice Brett Kavanaugh and harm himself. He arrived at Kavanaugh's house in the middle of the night on June 8th with a pistol, rounds of ammunition, a laser aiming device, a knife, pepper spray, lock picking tools, and other items that could be used for destruction. When he arrived, he saw two U.S. Marshals outside the home and decided to walk down the street. According to The Washington Post, after walking away from the home, Nicholas texted his sister to tell her of his intentions. His sister convinced him to turn himself in, which he would turn himself into the police without incident.

A blog called Give Him 15, said that the fact that Nicholas did not go through with his plan is a testament to the power of the many prayers that were being said for the Supreme Court in the many months leading up to the Supreme Court decision.

Companies that are assisting with coverage of abortions

The following is a list of major companies that are paying for abortions for their employees in areas abortion is not available in their home state or within a certain distance. Most of them assist/reimburse with travel costs through company health plans or policy. Some go as far as to provide hotels, meals, and childcare in order for someone to obtain an abortion. Every other company is bolded so you do not get lost in the list.




