A NOTE FROM AUGUSTINE PAYNE, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Last month, we covered the Democrat Party's support for late-term abortion because it came up in a previous Republican debate. Former White House Secretary to President Biden, Jen Psaki, stated that no one supports abortion up until birth. As we showed last month, the Democrat Party Platform and Democrat Party leaders do.

What I would like to cover this month is whether there are people who support late-term abortion. Some polls have estimated that around 20% of people believe that abortion should be legal through all nine months. That is 1 in 5 Americans.

In order for the mantra “my body, my choice” to be true on why abortion should be legal, among other factors, it follows that abortion be legal through all nine months. In talking with a few of these people (not a sufficient sample size) at the Dubuque County Fair Poll Table, there was a tendency to believe that all later-term abortions are rare and that they usually occur when the mother's life is at risk or there is a fetal anomaly. Is late-term abortion (after 20 weeks of gestation) rare? If you think about it as a percentage (1.3%, according to some sources), it doesn't sound like a significant number. When you take into consideration that it is 1.3% of over 930,000 abortions, there are over 12,000 late-term abortions. 12,000 abortions is a significant number. To put it in perspective, that is 1/5 of the population of Dubuque being wiped out in a year; that is the whole population of Platteville, Wisconsin, being wiped out; and almost three times the population of Dyersville. In conclusion, late-term abortions do happen, and I believe most people, regardless of where they are on the political spectrum, would agree that 12,000 innocent lives lost each year is cause for action.

We will cover next month whether late-term abortions occur when the mother's life is at risk or there is a fetal anomaly.

I share all of this with you about late-term abortion because I know abortion can be hard to talk about with family and friends, but it does come up, and hopefully this information can serve as a point of common ground for you and them—that you both agree these types of abortions are wrong.

DCRTL is Hiring

You may recall that back in June, Planned Parenthood announced that they were going to close three clinics and expand abortion in other clinics. Cedar Falls closed a couple of months ago, and Council Bluffs recently closed permanently. One of the clinics where they were going to start doing abortions was Planned Parenthood in Cedar Rapids. There is good news! The Planned Parenthood in Cedar Rapids has been “temporarily closed” for 47 days as of October 23rd. Join me on November 3rd to pray for their closure to become permanent. PRO-LIFE COURT & LEGISLATION UPDATE

Dear Pro-Life Friends –

I have local news, news from the East, news from the West, and news from the Midwest. In local news, Mary's Inn was denied a conditional use permit by a 4-1 vote on September 28, 2023, by the City of Dubuque Zoning Board of Adjustment. There was no credible evidence that Mary's Inn should be denied the permit, and the four "No" votes did not explain their reasoning with any specificity. It was disappointing that the board's denial of Mary's Inn application came after the Dubuque City Council voted unanimously, 7-0, to change the zoning while resoundingly endorsing Mary's Inn's mission. I am sure there are brighter days ahead for Mary's Inn, but for now, the unelected Board of Adjustment has blocked the path.

In news from the East, there are many people on the front lines of the right-to-life battle. Lauren Handy and four other co-defendants were convicted in a Washington DC court of violating the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances Act (FACE) when they peacefully sat down in the waiting room of an abortion clinic that was well known to offer late-term abortions. They were represented by an Iowa attorney, Martin Cannon, who argued that their actions were like the civil disobedience that Martin Luther King Jr. conducted in the 1960s, for which he was appropriately awarded a national holiday in his name. Appeals will be forthcoming because the trial court judge would not let Lauren and her co-defendants offer the "necessity" defense, which allows a person to use reasonable means to stop the death or serious injury of another person. Clearly, Handy and her co-defendants were trying to stop the killing of unborn people. They all face eleven years in jail. DCRTL will keep you posted as this case develops.

On the West Coast, David Daleiden, Sandra Merritt, and other defendants were successfully sued by Planned Parenthood for their investigative journalism reports from 2015, which you might remember. Daleiden and Merritt exposed abortionist money-hungry practices of killing unborn children while trying to preserve body parts, which they would then sell to universities and companies doing research. The abortionists described on video how they could kill an unborn child in a certain way, preserving specific body parts, such as an intact brain, heart, liver, etc. It was investigative journalism at its best to expose this grisly practice. Unfortunately, the trial court judge would not let the defendants offer the First Amendment freedom of the press as a defense. This case is on appeal and will be for years. In the meantime, the defendants have been saddled with judgments in the millions of dollars. They will now never be able to own personal property, because any such property will be seized by Planned Parenthood to satisfy the judgment against the defendants. It will take an appellate court ruling to overturn this grave injustice.

In the Midwest, there is some good news. The Illinois legislature recently passed senate bill 1909, which tried to label the activities of crisis pregnancy centers as "deceptive business practices." This law openly targets pro-life centers because the information handed out there and the services performed conflict with Illinois' pro-abortion ideology. Fortunately, federal judge Lain Johnston issued a preliminary injunction against it on August 3, 2023, ruling that such a law is a blatant violation of the First Amendment right to free speech. Such a rational, reasonable view of the situation was refreshing to read!

DCRTL will continue to keep you informed of these other developments on the legal and legislative fronts. Thank you for reading!

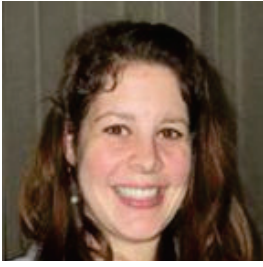

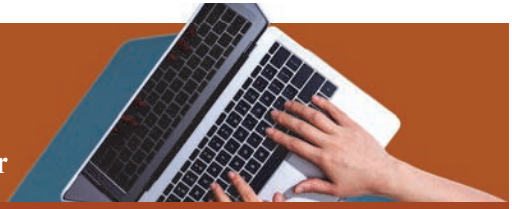
Cassie Schetgen
